Course Name Airport Carbon Emission Reduction Programme (ACAER)

About the Course

This course will provide an overview of the Airport Carbon Emission Reduction programme developed by ACI and the Greenhouse Gas Protocol upon which it is based. The different ACAER Programme Levels will be clearly explained and advantages/disadvantages of different “getting started” strategies will be discussed. The accreditation process and its costs will be explained so that each participant can understand what this means for their particular airport and situation. The basic concept of mapping current carbon footprint will be taught together with being able to identify feasible measures to reduce in future. The participant will also learn how to collect and check necessary data and what to do in cases where data might be missing or incomplete. The course will also introduce some basic notions about reducing carbon and energy which will be developed further in the Energy Management course (E03).

Learning Objectives

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Learn how to prepare and submit the ACAER application at least for Levels 1 and 2
- Explain to the different departments at an airport about the data that is needed to support this exercise
- To advise senior management on how progress through the ACAER framework will improve the airport’s perceived green credentials,
- Explain how the ACAER will also improve the cost efficiency of the airport in real terms
