Course Name Airport user charges, taxation, policies and economic regulation

About the Course

This course provides an overview of the key economic aspects of airports touching upon the drivers of airport revenues, costs and air transport demand from an African perspective. The aeronautical side of the airport business will be analyzed in more detail with an emphasis on policies of airport charges and the models of economic oversight that govern them. Industry policy positions will be presented in a balanced manner with a special focus on ICAO's policies on airport charges (doc 9082). International best practice guidance will be presented in tandem with selected African data and case studies — Interactive discussion questions will be provided to workshop participants as part of the curricula.

- Gain an understanding of the key charging principles of ICAO policies on charges doc 9082
