



REPUBLIC OF GHANA TO BEGIN USE OF GHANA CARD AS E-PASSPORT FOR GHANAIAAN TRAVELLERS TO GHANAIAAN AIRPORTS FROM END OF SECOND QUARTER 2022

Following a “Key Ceremony” at the headquarters of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in Montreal, Canada, on 9th February 2022, Ghana’s National Identity Card (the Ghana Card), is now duly recognized globally as a valid ID card-passport, a Machine-Readable Travel Document (MRTD) that can be read and verified by the ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD) at most airports.

Ghana Airports Company Limited announces to all airports and airlines that, **from end of second quarter 2022**, holders of a valid Ghana Card should be allowed to board Flights to Ghana, without the need for a visa.
