About the Course

The practice of the airside Operation course provides participants with a broad understanding of airside operations at an airport. Participants will develop an understanding of the various components of Airside Operations and how these components interact with each other to form an operational system. - Describe the international and national regulatory frameworks and responsibilities that govern airside design and operation.
- Manage non-compliances on the airside.
- Learn how to improve safety on airside through inspections.
- Identify the non-compliance issues on airside.
- Learn how to manage non-compliance situations.
- Apply the Standards and Recommendations of Annex 14 to resolve airside problems.
- Be part of a Safety team or an Aerodrome Certification team
- Describe the major components of the manoeuvring area including runways, taxiways, visual aids, navigation aids and the major characteristics of each
- Describe the key components of airside lighting systems, signage, and instrument landing systems.
- Identify the different types of aprons found on the airside including various terminal apron layouts and their associated lighting, marking and signs.
- Describe the different types of support buildings that are located on the airside and the purpose of each.
- Identify the ICAO annexes that influence the design of the airside perimeter with regards to airside security and operations
- Describe the various personnel that work on the airside and the organisations to which they belong.
