



## Certificate I in Airside Safety

### *Overview*

The Certificate I in Airside Safety combines five online safety courses into a certificate level program that provides participants with a broad knowledge and understanding of the key elements of airside safety and how these elements combine as part of the airport's overall Safety Management System.

This course is ideal for initial or recurrent safety training for all airport employees and service provider personnel.

### *Objectives*

On completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Understand the basic components of airside safety including the unique nature of the airside, the various roles and responsibilities required to maintain a high level of safety, the major elements of airside safety and some of the common hazards that they may encounter
- Apply the key principles, concepts and elements of Safety Management Systems with the goal of increasing aviation safety
- Understand the fundamental concepts of human factors and effectively manage human performance issues at an airport
- Determine approaches to enhance safety, improve operations and prevent or reduce accidents, incidents and occurrences on the apron
- Understand the threat posed by Foreign Object Debris (FOD) and the key elements of a FOD program that can help airports to successfully manage this threat

### **Who should enrol?**

- Airport managers, supervisors or personnel with operations, safety or compliance responsibilities
- Airport ground staff
- Airport and ground operations service providers
- Personnel responsible for training and facilitating airside operational staff
- Anyone interested in a career in airport operations and/or safety

### *Course Content*

The Certificate I in Airside Safety consists of the following five courses:

1. Airside Safety Training
2. Safety Management Systems Training
3. Human Factors Safety Training
